OPTIONAL ACTIVITY DESCRIPTIONS – DESTINATION WISCONSIN

KAYAKING *(ages 8-12 child rate)*

Saturday, July 18

1:30 pm – 5:30 pm

Ages 8 and up (Ages 8-12 to be accompanied by an adult) After a short motor coach ride and a brief introduction and lifejacket fitting, tuck into a single-person sea kayak for a guided tour on Lake Michigan or Elkhart Lake. You will be in the water for approximately 2.5 - 3 hours. Wear comfortable clothing and be sure to bring a hat and sunglasses. You may get wet so wear clothing that CAN get wet, such as a swimming suit with shorts and a t-shirt. Bring something dry to wear back to the hotel. Tour includes private transportation, private guided kayak tour, kayak and equipment, snack and guide.

WADE HOUSE TOUR *(ages 5-12 child rate; age 4 and under free)*

1:30 pm – 5:45 pm

All ages (Ages 12 and under to be accompanied by an adult) You will take a short (less than 30 minutes) motor coach ride to the Wade House. The Wade House is an interactive historical site centered around the Wade's Stagecoach Inn built in the 1850's. You will visit the Stagecoach Inn, a blacksmith shop, a water-powered sawmill and see a collection of hand or horse-drawn carriages. Horse drawn carriage rides are available and included with this tour in the beautiful surrounding Kettle Moraine State Forest. A wonderful café and extensive gift shop is also onsite. Wear comfortable shoes. Tour includes private transportation, entrance fees and guide.

TWO RIVERS & MANITOWOC

(ages 5-12 child rate; age 4 and under free)

Sunday, July 19

1:15 pm – 6:15 pm

All ages (Ages 12 and under to be accompanied by an adult) You will board a motor coach for an approximate 45-minute ride to Two Rivers. First stop is at Historic Washington House. Children of all ages will enjoy the antique toy collection and the Victorian dollhouse. The old-time saloon features Ed Berner's Ice Cream Parlor – home of the original Ice Cream Sundae. Enjoy the red, white and blue Washington House Sundae as well as other soda fountain specialties (additional cost). Next, travel a short 15 minutes to Manitowoc and the Midwest's largest maritime museum, which offers guided tours of the nation's most completely restored World War II submarine, the USS Cobia. The museum also offers a gallery dedicated to Wisconsin-built recreational boats, hands-on activities in the Children's Waterways Room and Little Lakefarer's Room, a working triple-expansion marine steam engine and a sport-fishing simulator. Tour includes private transportation, tour guide and entrance fees.

KAYAKING *(ages 8-12 child rate)*

1:30 pm – 5:30 pm

Ages 8 and up (Ages 8-12 accompanied by an adult)

CHARTER FISHING *(ages 5-12 child rate)*

3:15 pm – 8:30 pm

Ages 5 and up (Ages under 18 to be accompanied by an adult.) You will board a motor coach for a short (less than 30 minute) ride to Sheboygan to your private fishing boat. Enjoy fishing aboard a tournament-winning and fully equipped sport fishing boat. Whether you have a little fishing experience or a lot, an experienced crew of captains and first mates assist you in an exciting and successful fishing outing of a lifetime! Wear comfortable clothing and soft-soled shoes and be sure to bring hats and sunglasses. Rain gear is not a necessity; however the boats will go if it is raining so long as the water is not terribly choppy or the wind really fierce. Guests are allowed to keep their catch, so they can bring coolers if they wish to take it home. All fish not taken by guests are donated to a local charity/food pantry. Tour includes private transportation, private fishing boat, bait and tackle, fishing license and onboard beverages and snacks.

HISTORIC CEDARBURG

(ages 5-12 child rate; age 4 and under free)

9:00 am – 12:45 pm

All ages (Ages 12 and under to be accompanied by an adult) The day begins with private transportation to the quaint village of Cedarburg, Wisconsin, a U.S. historical city. Whether your passion is antiquing, quilting, Southwest cooking, decorating or just plain browsing, there is something for everyone in this wonderful little village.

BIKES & BEERS – HARLEY DAVIDSON & MILLER BREWERY

(ages 5-12 child rate; age 4 and under free)

All ages (Ages 12 and under to be accompanied by an adult) After a one-hour motor coach ride into Milwaukee, you begin your afternoon at Miller Brewery. During the tour you will learn the Miller process, learn about its history and best of all you will get to sample the brew! Next, travel a short distance to the Harley-Davidson Museum. At 105 years in the making, the new Harley-Davidson Museum tells the stories of the history and culture of Harley-Davidson through photographs, videos and fascinating artifacts.
