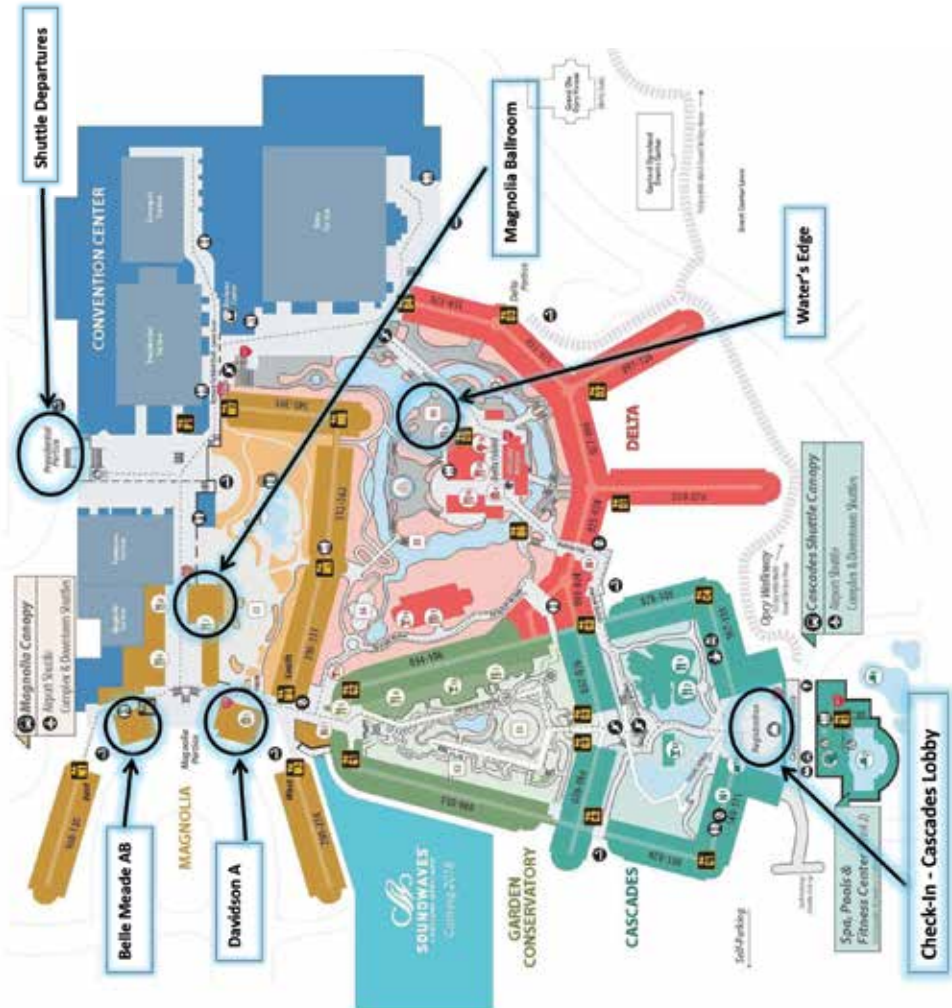

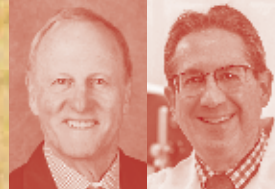
WELCOME TO MUSIC CITY
