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**Downtown Camden Shopping      Thursday 7/15, 9:30 am – 12 pm (travel is approx. 15-20 min. one way)**

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Board the local trolley right at the Samoset Resort front lobby to Camden Harbor for shopping and lunch. Camden Harbor features a wide variety of unique, locally owned shops. You will not find chain stores and national retailers that fill your local malls. When you visit Camden you will instead find numerous quaint storefronts that line the streets of the downtown area. In our shops you will come across an amazing range of intriguing gifts, fine clothing, books, and many items made right here in Maine. We have stores that sell custom jewelry, one of a kind artwork and beautiful crafts made by local artisans as well as stores that sell hilarious Maine inspired t-shirts, and stores that sell everything in between. Whether you're looking for something special to remind you of your trip to Maine or a gift for someone back home, our friendly shop keepers will be glad to help you find just the right thing. *All ages. Includes transportation and trolley guide.*

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**Lobster Boat Tours      Thursday, 7/15, Friday, 7/16, and Saturday, 7/17, 2 pm - 3:15 pm and 3:30 pm – 4:45 pm**

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Board the "Captain Jack" 30 foot authentic downeast lobster boat right from the Samoset Resort Dock. Experience a unique adventure on board a traditional working lobster boat. Join Captain Hale on a 1-1/4 hr. cruise. Catch a glimpse of seals, harbor porpoise, an occasional sunfish and maybe a whale. Watch as Captain Hale hauls his traps, get up close and personal with the lobsters, crabs, starfish, sea urchins and other exciting creatures from the sea. Bring your camera to take panoramic pictures of the Owls Head Light house and the Rockland Breakwater Lighthouse. Enjoy the sounds of herring gulls, black back gulls, terns and osprey. Learn a little local history and experience the daily life of a local lobster man. *There are fishing poles on board. You can try catching a mackerel or maybe a cod. All ages. Includes transportation and guide. Casual comfortable shoes, and a jacket or sweatshirt recommended.*

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**Kayaking (Ocean)      Thursday, 7/15, Friday, 7/16, & Saturday, 7/17, 1:30 pm – 4:30 pm (travel is approx. 20 min. one way)**

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Board the local trolley right from the Samoset Resort front lobby to Camden Harbor. This tour offers an introduction to sea kayaking and a unique view of one of Maine's most delightful and active harbors - Camden. We will leave from the public landing to paddle amongst tall-masted schooners and recreational boats. As we look for seabirds and harbor seals, you will enjoy magnificent views of Penobscot Bay. We will head toward the historic working lighthouse on Curtis Island and paddle around the island if weather permits. As we return to the harbor, the Camden Hills offer a dramatic and spectacular sight. This tour is approx. 2 hours with instruction. **Participants must be 14 years of age and older.** *Includes transportation, guide and equipment. We recommend that you bring/wear clothing appropriate to the activity and weather. AVOID COTTON. Footwear that can get wet, a hat for sun cover or warmth, a fleece top or equivalent (wool sweater), rain gear (hat, jacket, pants), paddling jacket or windbreaker, quick drying shorts, t-shirt (synthetic material), bathing suit (optional), water bottle (full!), waterproof sunscreen, chap stick with sunscreen, sunglasses with strap, favorite high energy snack, and binoculars/camera (waterproof suggested).*

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**Cellardoor Winery Tour      Thursday, 7/15, 1:30 - 4:45 pm (travel time is approx. 30-40 min. one way)**

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Transportation from the Samoset Resort to the Cellardoor Winery in Lincolnville. Enjoy a private winery tour, a children's hike around the vineyard, and local Maine wine, cheese and chocolate. A tradition of stewardship - The vineyard, its accompanying fields, fruit trees and pond inhabit a special corner of the world. Located in a valley between Cameron and Levenseller Mountains and just five miles from Camden Harbor, the property has a unique microclimate and a rich history. *All ages. Includes transportation, wine, cheese, chocolate, tour and children's hike.*

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**Sunset Schooner Cruise      Thursday, 7/15, 5 pm – sunset (travel time is approx. 20 min. one way)**

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Board the local trolley right from the Samoset Resort front entrance. Sail the Maine Coast aboard Schooner Yacht HERON, a 65' John Alden designed Classic Schooner Yacht. Experience the thrill of sailing a classic wooden schooner. The Schooner Yacht HERON is truly the finest daysailer in the fleet. HERON is family built, owned and operated by the Bower family of Camden, Maine. Enjoy a Gourmet Sunset Schooner Tour with good food, good company, great sailing and a beautiful sunset. The boat is BYOB for alcohol/beverages. Personal coolers are permitted on board. *All ages. Includes hors d'oeuvres, transportation, boat and guide. Dress comfortably for the weather, it may be cooler on the water. Soft soled, non marking shoes, camera & binoculars encouraged.*

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**The Eco Schooner Cruise      Friday, 7/16, & Saturday, 7/17, 1:15 pm – 5 pm (travel time is approx. 20 min. one way)**

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Board the local trolley right from the Samoset Resort front entrance. Sail the Maine Coast aboard Schooner Yacht HERON, as described above under the Sunset Schooner Cruise. On this sail you will enjoy the Indian Island Light Eco Tour. Learn about the history of Rockport Harbor... the shipbuilding & the export of lime and ice. Explore the history of magical Indian Island Light and its decline in the 1930's. Enjoy the educational narrative from glaciers forming the bay to the migration of the marine mammals and seabird. With fair wind and tide, spot the seals on Robinson's Rock, the birthplace of the famous Andre the seal. The boat is BYOB for alcohol/beverages. Personal coolers are permitted on board. *All ages. Includes snacks, transportation, boat and guide. Dress comfortably for the weather. We suggest layers as it may be cooler on the water. Soft soled, non marking shoes recommended. Sunscreen, sunglasses, hat, sweater or jacket, camera & binoculars.*

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**Owl's Head Light House Tour      Friday, 7/16, 2 pm – 5 pm (travel time is approx. 20 min. one way)**

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Board the local trolley from the Samoset Resort and head through downtown Rockland to enjoy a guided lighthouse tour (Built in 1825) and the scenic grounds and beach area overlooking the Penobscot Bay in Owls Head Light State Park. *All ages. Includes transportation and guide. Casual comfortable shoes and a jacket/sweatshirt recommended. You may want to collect items on the beach to take back home.*

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**Hiking in Camden Hills State Park      Saturday, 7/17, 2 pm – 6 pm (travel time is approx. 20 min. one way)**

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You will board the local trolley with your hiking guide from the Samoset Resort and head to the Camden Hills State park. This area has been inspiring writers and artists for years. Edna St. Vincent Millay spent much of her time in what is now Camden Hills State Park. The village of Camden's slogan is "Where the Mountains Meet the Sea" -- most appropriate because, aside from Mount Desert Island, nowhere else on the eastern seaboard of the US do the mountains meet the sea. This Park offers more than 20 miles of hiking trails. Moderate terrain, 3-5 miles, elevation of 800-1000 ft. *Includes transportation and guide. Appropriate hiking attire, water bottles, snack and physical shape recommended.*
